

WHAT IS A WOWGR AND DELIVERY ORDER?

WOWGR stands for **Warehouse-keepers and Owners of Warehoused Goods**

Regulations; WOWGR is a register that revenue traders must be accepted onto in order to own whisky held in duty suspense. When you are accepted onto the register you receive a certificate that states which part of the regulations you are covered by—for example a "warehouse-keeper" is different from an "owner of warehoused goods." Therefore, the question you should be asking is, technically, do I need to be accepted onto the WOWGR register in order to buy a cask?

At **Golden Dram**, when you buy a cask you will receive a **Delivery Order**. The **Delivery Order** ensures that ownership of the cask is transferred into your name at the warehouse where the cask is stored and not into the company name that sold you the cask.

Insurance and storage is for the account of the buyer, effective immediately from the time of transfer of ownership.

Private individuals do not need to be WOWGR registered in order to own a cask with a **Delivery Order**.

WHY IS YOUR CASK STORED IN A BONDED WAREHOUSE?

A bonded warehouse is a secure storage facility regulated by customs authorities where goods, such as whisky casks, are stored under duty suspension.

Whisky casks are stored under bond to defer these taxes until the product is bottled and removed from the warehouse for sale or export.

This arrangement ensures compliance with tax regulations while providing buyers with key financial advantages, such as:

CGT Exemption: When you sell your whisky cask, no Capital Gains Tax (CGT) applies in the UK, as casks are classified as "wasting assets" with a lifespan under 50 years.

Preservation of Value: The whisky matures under optimal conditions, enhancing its quality and potential market value.

Transparency and Security: Bonded warehouses are strictly monitored, ensuring traceability, authenticity, and regulatory adherence.

ATTENTION UK TAX RESIDENTS

Whisky falls under a Wasting asset exemption (CGT Exemption).

A wasting asset is an asset with a predictable life not exceeding fifty years at the time when it was acquired, TCGA92/S44(1).

NOTE: For Whisky Cask buyers, bonded storage not only safeguards their whisky cask purchase but also optimizes its financial and maturation potential.

What is Scotch Whisky?

Scotch whisky often simply called Whisky or Scotch, is **malt whisky or grain** whisky made in Scotland

In summary, Scotch Whisky is:

- Mashed, fermented, distilled and matured in Scotland from only cereals, water and yeast
- Matured for a minimum of 3 years in oak casks not exceeding 700 litres
- Bottled at a minimum strength of 40% ABV
- **Distilled below 94.8% ABV** so that it retains the flavour and aroma derived from its raw materials
- No flavouring or sweetening is permitted.

Scotch whisky is produced in **five key regions of Scotland**, each contributing distinct characteristics to the flavour profiles of the whisky due to variations in climate, water sources, and production techniques.

Here's an overview:

1. Highlands

- **Characteristics:** Diverse flavour profiles ranging from light and floral to rich and peaty.
- Impact on Flavour: The region's vast geographical size leads to variations:
 - Northern Highland whiskies are often full-bodied with rich, spicy, and sometimes smoky notes.
 - Central and Southern Highlands produce lighter, more floral whiskies.
 - o Coastal Highlands can have a briny, maritime influence.
- Notable Distilleries: Glenmorangie, Dalmore, Oban.

2. Speyside

- Characteristics: Elegant, fruity, and often sweeter.
- Impact on Flavour: Known as the heart of Scotch whisky production, Speyside benefits from rich barley-growing conditions and soft water.
 Whiskies here often feature flavors of apple, pear, honey, and malt, with subtle sherry influences.
- Notable Distilleries: Macallan, Glenlivet, Glenfiddich.

3. Islay

- Characteristics: Bold, smoky, and heavily peated.
- **Impact on Flavour:** Islay's proximity to the sea influences its whiskies, imparting briny, medicinal, and peaty characteristics. The island's use of peat in the malting process defines the region's distinctive style.
- Notable Distilleries: Laphroaig, Ardbeg, Lagavulin.

4. Lowlands

- **Characteristics**: Light, grassy, and gentle.
- **Impact on Flavour:** Lowland whiskies are known for their delicate profiles with notes of fresh herbs, cereal, and floral elements. The region's soft landscape contributes to its understated, approachable style.
- Notable Distilleries: Auchentoshan, Glenkinchie.

5. Campbeltown

- Characteristics: Rich, robust, and slightly salty.
- **Impact on Flavour:** Campbeltown's coastal location imparts a briny, maritime influence, while the whiskies often feature a balance of malty sweetness and smoky complexity.
- Notable Distilleries: Springbank, Glen Scotia

Summary of Flavour Influences


Geography and climate: Coastal regions often impart **briny** and **maritime** notes, while **inland** regions tend toward **sweeter**, **fruitier** profiles.

Water source: Soft vs. mineral-rich water influences texture and flavour development.

Peat usage: Regions like **Islay** heavily incorporate peat, resulting in smoky profiles, while others use less or no peat.

These regional distinctions allow Scotch whisky to cater to a wide range of palates, adding depth and diversity to its global appeal.

FROM GRAIN TO GLASS

Scotch Whisky must, by law, be distilled and matured in Scotland in oak casks, in a bonded warehouse for at least three years and bottled at a minimum alcoholic strength of 40% ABV (Alcohol by Volume). Once it leaves the bonded warehouse, whether in a cask or in glass, duty & tax become payble.

The robust legal protection of Scotch - vital to safeguard a spirit globally renowned for its quality – has grown over time.

The first definition of Scotch in UK law was secured by 1933, with a dedicated Scotch Whisky Act in 1988 and new Scotch Whisky Regulations in 2009. These comprehensive rules govern the Scotch Whisky industry.

The Scotch Whisky Association (SWA) has introduced an amendment to the Scotch Whisky Product Specification, expanding the range of casks permissible for the maturation or finishing of Scotch Whisky. While traditional casks—such as those previously used for bourbon, sherry, rum, wine, or beer—remain the industry standard, the new guidelines introduce flexibility, allowing for other cask types under strict conditions.





FROM GRAIN TO GLASS

Permissible Casks


Scotch Whisky can now be matured or finished in new oak casks or oak casks previously used to mature wine, beer/ale, or spirits, provided the casks meet the following criteria:

- Exclusions Based on Ingredients: Casks must not have been used to mature beverages containing stone fruits, or beer/ale, wine, or spirits with added fruit, flavourings, or sweeteners.
- Cider Exclusion: Cider casks are not permitted, as cider does not qualify as beer, wine, or spirit under the regulations.

Additional Conditions

Even if a cask meets the above requirements, two critical factors determine its acceptability:

- Traditional Maturation Process: The previous use of the cask must align with the traditional production processes of the beverage concerned. For example, gin casks are disqualified because maturation is not part of traditional gin production.
- Taste, Aroma, and Colour Compliance: Scotch Whisky must maintain its characteristic taste, aroma, and colour derived from its production process. Any deviation that could harm Scotch Whisky's reputation is prohibited.



HOW TO EXIT / DIVEST

First and foremost, **ALL WHISKY CASKS** are destined to be bottled, that is the end of the Whisky lifecycle.

Regardless of your motivation for buying a Whisky Cask, its worth considering what your exit point will be. While there are various options available, your choice may be determined by a number of factors. While a connoisseur may be focused on the optimal age for bottling to enjoy with friends and family, the investor may be looking to exit at a particular time horizon or desired ROI (Return on Investment).

Whisky Production Terms

- ABV (Alcohol by Volume): The percentage of alcohol in a whisky.
- MASH: The mixture of ground grains and water that is fermented to produce alcohol.
- WASH: The liquid created after fermentation, which is then distilled.
- WORT: The liquid extracted during the mashing process before fermentation.
- **ANGEL'S SHARE**: The portion of whisky that evaporates during maturation in a cask.
- **CASK STRENGTH:** Whisky bottled directly from the cask without dilution, typically higher in ABV.
- **FERMENTATION**: The process of converting sugars into alcohol using yeast.
- MASH BILL: The grain recipe used in whisky production (e.g., barley, corn, rye).
- **DISTILLERY:** A facility where whisky is produced.
- **SINGLE MALT:** Whisky made from malted barley in a single distillery.
- **BLENDED WHISKY:** A mix of whiskies from different distilleries, which may include single malt and grain whisky.

Cask-Specific Terms

- **UNDER BOND:** Storage in a bonded warehouse, deferring tax payments until the whisky is sold.
- **HOGSHEAD:** A cask size of approximately 250 litres, often used for whisky maturation.
- **BUTT:** A larger cask, typically 500 litres. Usually a cask previously used to store Sherry, hence the term, "Sherry Butt".
- OCTAVE: A small cask of about 50 litres, used for finishing and rapid aging.
- **REFILL CASK:** A cask that has previously held whisky, imparting subtler flavours.
- **FIRST-FILL CASK:** A cask being used for whisky maturation for the first time, imparting stronger flavours.
- **FINISHING:** The process of transferring whisky to a different cask type (e.g., sherry, port) for additional flavour.
- **CHAR:** The burned interior of a cask, which influences the whisky's flavour profile.

Investment and Financial Terms

- CAPEX (Capital Expenditure): Costs incurred when acquiring whisky casks.
- EXIT STRATEGY: Plan for selling whisky casks or bottled whisky for profit.
- YIELD: The amount of whisky remaining after evaporation and maturation.
- ASSET CLASS: Whisky casks as a tangible, alternative investment asset.

- LEGS: The streaks left on the side of a glass after swirling, indicating viscosity.
- SLAINTE: A Gaelic toast meaning "health."
- EXPRESSION: A specific variant or release of a whisky from a distillery.
- **VATTING:** The process of mixing whiskies from different casks to create a specific flavour profile.
- **DRAM:** A small serving of whisky, typically used colloquially.
